

Essex Heritage Photo Safari Participant Information

All attendees to Photo Safaris must be registered. Photo Safaris are limited to 35 attendees each session. Once a Photo Safari reaches capacity and the waitlist exceeds 10 individuals, a second session in the afternoon may be scheduled. If a second session becomes available individuals on the waitlist will be notified immediately to register and pay for the Photo Safari.

Example Photo Safari Itinerary:

7:00am: Arrival, onsite check-in, and distribution of the equipment*
Overview of equipment and event.
8:00am: Photo Shoot commences (Locale to be determined by event leader)
11-11:30am: Photo Safari wrap up & equipment return

Equipment Loans:

Equipment will be loaned on a first-come, first-served basis. You can try out one camera and lens and then exchange it for a second camera or lens as often as you like (based upon availability).

In order to use the available equipment, you **MUST** have pre-registered and paid, **MUST** be 18 years or older and **MUST** leave your drivers license and a credit card with Essex Heritage at registration (in order to borrow camera equipment). Participants are responsible for any and all damage to the equipment.

** Please note: Tamron is a lens manufacturer. If you choose to join the Tamron Photo Safari, you must bring your own camera. Lens mounts will be provided at the Safari.*

Representatives from each camera company, tech experts from Hunt's Photo & Video, and in some cases, a professional photographer sponsored by the camera company will be on hand to guide you through your Photo Safari experience. In addition, Essex Heritage staff and staff from the host site will be present to support the event. All staff will be on hand to work to ensure that attendees maximize their enjoyment of the Photo Safari experience.
