Jack holds a BS from Gordon College, an MRE from Gordon Conwell Theological Seminary and an MBA from the University of Southern New Hampshire.

In addition to his volunteer service to Essex Heritage as a former Commissioner and now Trustee, Jack also serves in an Executive Board capacity for the North Shore United Way, is an active member and founding Chairman of the North Shore Chamber of Commerce, VP of Beverly Main Streets and a Board member for the North Shore Vocational School, Beverly School for the Deaf, Northeast Senior Health Board and YMCA of the North Shore.

Jack also served as President of the Beverly Rotary Club and the Greater Beverly Chamber of Commerce. He is past President of the New England Association for Healthcare Philanthropy, a former Chairman of the Board for the Association for Healthcare Philanthropy and has served as Chairman of the Board for the American Heart Association Massachusetts Affiliate, among others.
